# **ViPlex Handy Introduction**

ViPlex Handy is a software for managing screens via LAN. The software can be used for the management of the Taurus series players. ViPlex Handy supports Android and iOS.

Advantages of ViPlex Handy:

- Friendly user interface. UI design takes full account of the habits of users.
- Easy to use. The Taurus can be wirelessly connected and easily accessed.
- Synchronous playback, which is capable of playing the same content on different screens synchronously.
- Smart brightness adjustment, which is capable of setting automatic and timed brightness adjustment.
- Dual WiFi functionality, which is capable of setting WiFi AP mode and WiFi Sta mode.
- 4G connection, which is capable of setting mobile data network of the Taurus with 4G module.
- Dual-mode (synchronous and asynchronous), which is capable of setting video output mode.
- Adaptive display, which is capable of displaying pictures automatically according to screen size.
- Terminal binding, which can easily bind the Taurus with cloud-based publishing system VNNOX and cloud-based monitoring system NovaiCare.

# **Download and Installation**

#### **Downloading Installation Package**

Method 1: Scan the QR code below using an iPhone or iPad (iOS 10.0 and above) to download ViPlex Handy installation package.



Method 2: Search "ViPlex Handy" in APP Store to download and install the ViPlex Handy.

#### **Installing Software**

Installation of ViPlex Handy is the same as other applications.



### **Required Information**

Please get actual values of the information in Table 3-1.

## **Operating Steps**

- Step 1 Connect WiFi AP of the Taurus series products or external router.
- Step 2 Start ViPlex Handy.

System can automatically detect the Taurus series products and refresh "Screen list". Users can also slide down "Screen list" to manually refresh the list.

- Image: denotes that Taurus is online and you can log into it.
- denotes that Taurus is offline and you cannot log into it.

User Guide (iOS)

- denotes that Taurus login is successful.
- Step 3 Click "Connect" behind the screen name.
- Step 4 Enter username and password, and click "Login".

The system saves the relevant user name and password of current screen automatically after successful login.

### **Related Operation**

After the system saves the user name and password, users can do the following while logging in Taurus.

- Connect: Click to log in Taurus.
- Forget: Delete the user name and password of current screen.
- Delete: Delete current screen from the screen list.

		Auto adjustment parameters: Divide the environment brightness range from the maximum value to the minimum value into several equal intervals and set the relevant screen brightness of each interval. Select "Auto brightness adjust" and the screen brightness will be adjusted automatically according to current ambient brightness.

	Correct Time	Setting the rules for correcting time.
		To enable synchronous playing on different Taurus units, keeping the time in sync is one of the basic conditions.

			Users can choose following ways to correct time according to actual situation:
			Close: Do not correct time.
			<ul> <li>NTP: After accessing Taurus to the Internet, correct time according to the NTP server of the internet. Click "Server" to correct time automatically and set NTP server address.</li> </ul>
			• Lora: Correct the time of Taurus via synchronous module. Set Taurus as master or slave device. Correct the time of slave device with master device via Lora network.
			Time parameters of Lora:
			<ul> <li>Group ID: It is required to enter the same group ID for the Taurus units requiring time synchronization, namely, assign these Taurus units to the same group.</li> </ul>
			• Device type: Set current Taurus unit as master or slave device. Correct the time of slave device with master device via Lora.
		STAR	<ul> <li>Time Auto-sync: To correct the time of master device via the NTP server of the Internet, it is required to enable "Time Auto-sync" and set NTP server address.</li> </ul>

	Adding videos and set the playback of the videos.
GIF	Adding GIF dynamic pictures.
